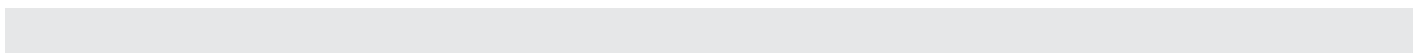
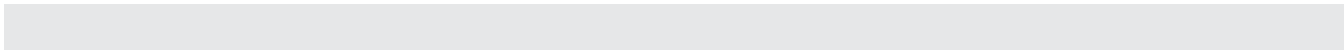

AUDITING COURSES

Students may enroll as auditors for a fee. The instructor's permission on the audit form is required. The fee must be paid at the time of enrollment and is non-refundable. College of 1XUVLQJ DQG +HDOWK 6FLHQFH open to auditors. Auditors are subject to the conditions of enrollment established by the instructor, but do not take course examinations.

Students who audit a course must establish regular DWWHQGDQFH GXULQJ WKH they will be submitted as a "No Show." No credit is earned for audited courses, but the course name and designation "AU" are listed on the transcript.

Ordinarily, students may not audit studio or laboratory performance-based courses. Students' work in audited classes will not be formally assessed and no grades will be issued. Auditors are expected to read required texts and are permitted to ask and answer questions in class.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

CLASS ATTENDANCE

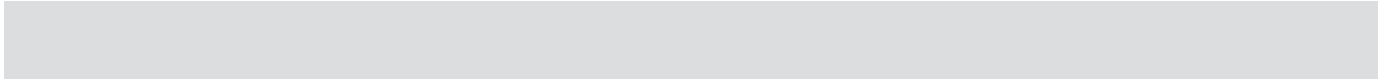

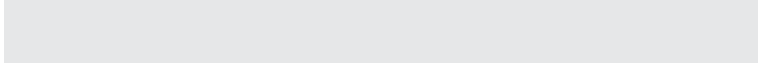
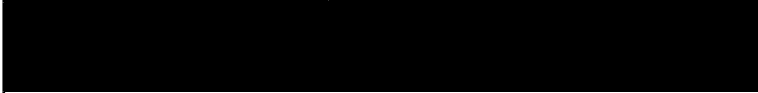
INDEPENDENT STUDY

Independent Study is an intensive, highly individualized course taken for knowledge enhancement beyond the courses offered in a particular area of interest and covering material not described in the University catalog in any

other format. An Independent Study is offered by a department only to its majors and minors.

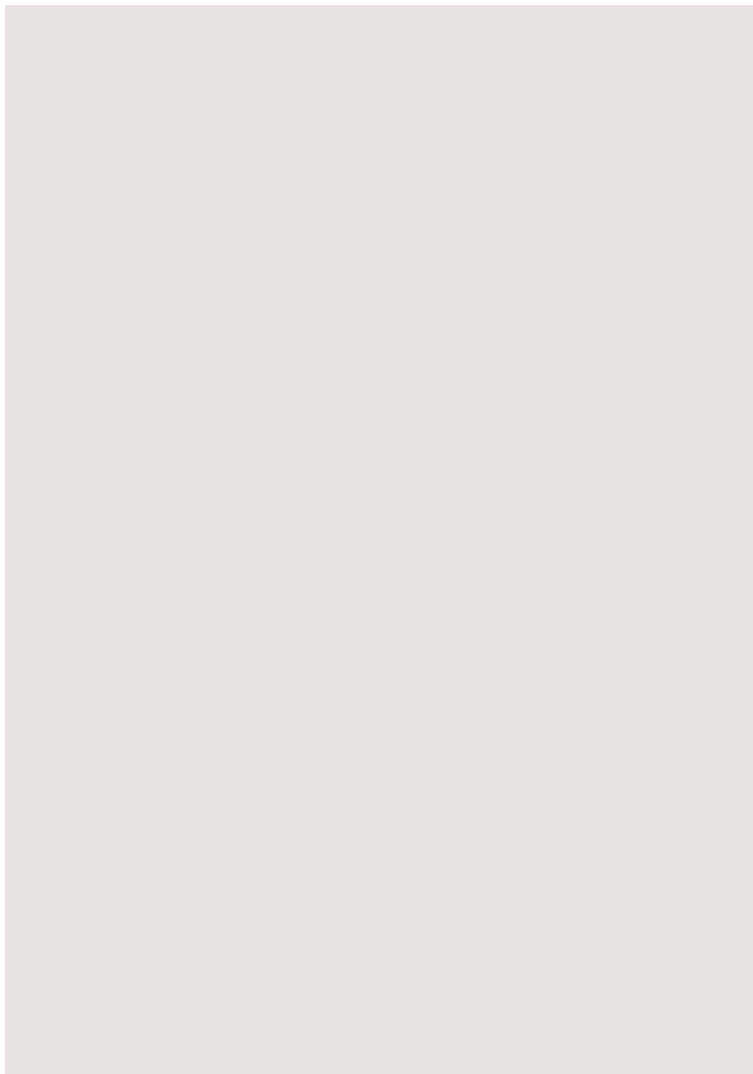
